Overview - what this workshop covers

Creating Stickers. Logos and Spray Painting Stencils

Date: 18 Feb 2010	Time: 10.30am-1.00pm / 2.00pm-4.30pm
Context: This week participants continue learning image processing and continue to personalise their computer. Workshop to generate stencil images- slogans, images, looking at other artists' and designers' work- discuss possible themes- could include green/tech reuse issues	Learning Objectives: Continuing from the previous week, image manipulation skills in Inkscape and GIMP. Stencils created can be used to spray paint participants' designs on the laptops. Learning about the cultural context of creating and sharing non-standard media for artistic and activist purposes – eg Banksy, Adbusters
