Media files created by internet users are an increasingly important part of social networking websites and the internet in general.	How to upload audio and video to the web. It is hoped that participants will wish to learn to edit their own mobile phone videos.
Video editing is probably the most challenging activity in this set of sessions.	How to get the most out of sharing audio and video content on the web.
